- A – San Jose** Holy Redeemer Lutheran Church, 1948 The Alameda at McKendrie, hall, downstairs, 1<sup>st</sup> door at the bottom of the stairs. From 280 take 880 East, exit The Alameda, turn South, then turn left immediately onto McKendrie.
- B – Mt. View** El Camino Hospital, 2500 Grant Road (corner of South Dr. and Solace Place.) Enter on Solace. New Hospital, ground floor, Conference Room C. Entrance is to the left of the Emergency Room (SE side).
- C – Palo Alto** First Lutheran Church, 600 Homer Avenue (corner of Homer & Webster). Enter hall on Homer.
- D – Palo Alto** First United Methodist Church, 625 Hamilton Avenue at Webster, Wesley Room. (Near University & Middlefield.) Go up cement stairs into bldg., (corner of Byron) thru double doors, first room on the right.
- E – San Jose** Billy de Frank Center, 938 The Alameda, San Jose, CA 95126
